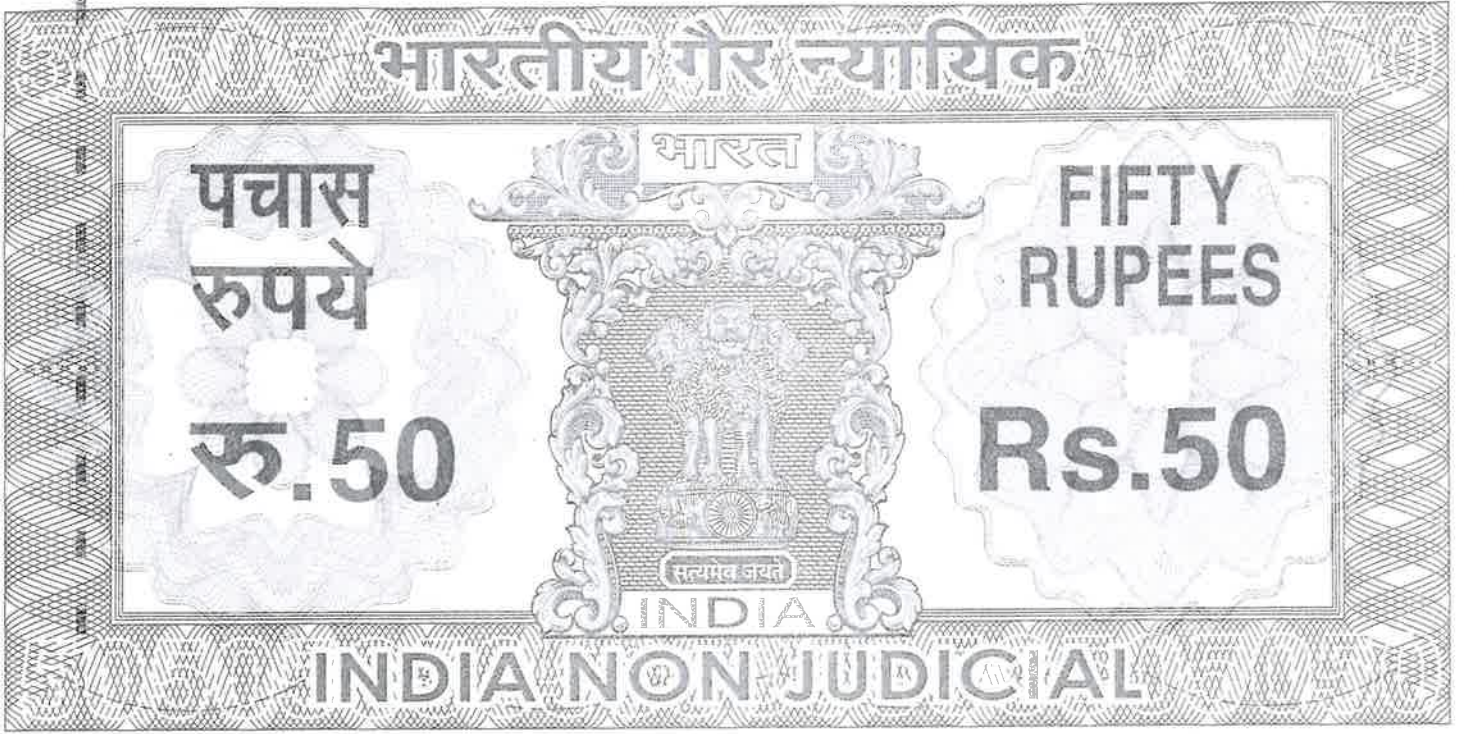

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)**  
**BETWEEN**  
**ASTRONE SOLUTIONS AND SERVICES**  
**(CHENNAI)**  
**AND**  
**SRI MUTHUKUMARAN INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY**  
**(CHENNAI)**

This contract is between AstroneSolutions and Services, here in after called AICL situated in Chennai, Tamil Nadu, and a research center for educational empowerment service includes accreditation; research Journal, Publication, Skill development training and consultancy, and Sri Muthukumaran Institute Of Technology, here in after called SMIT situated in Chennai, Tamil Nadu.

## 1. Objective of the contract

- A. To promote and enhance technology and skill enhancement Programs, Interest between AICL & SMIT (Computer applications and computer science programs).
- B. To provide advice for the implementation of technology and skill development to the students through technology and personal development training programs, Projects, and case studies to enhance quality education at SMIT
- C. To encourage advancement in contemporary technology of SMIT to a Collaboration with a techno consultant at AICL.
- D. To Provide various courses and hands-on projects to enhance the technical knowledge of the students as well as to give an industry experience inside the campus.

## 2. Technical Area of Collaboration

- A. The Collaboration includes but is not limited to continuing industry demand for technological advancement, research, and development training programs to improve the quality of students through short-term & long-term certificate courses / Programs, projects, case studies, and consultancy at SMIT.
- B. Techno Consultation at AICL could be sent to SMIT for providing necessary training, project assistance, case study, and research support to the students.
- C. AICL Provides technology advancement interaction by delivering Special Trainers at SMIT on
  - Data Science - Data analytics - Machine Learning and Deep Learning
  - Full Stack Development Engineering
  - Python programming and automation
  - Certified Ethical Hacking (CEH)
  - Business Communication and communicative English
  - Web Design and development
  - On-demand topics relevant to Industry employable skill development programs
  - Provide necessary support for the establishment of labs, training & placement assistance, etc.,

### **3. Proposed Modes of Collaboration**

- A. AICL and SMIT Propose to collaborate through the following:
- B. Cooperation and promotion of Research, Training, case study, and projects in mutual interest areas.
- C. Online & Offline modes of interaction agreed upon between AICL and SMIT
- D. A Specific Plan will be Worked out by the institute depending on the availability of resources. a specific agreement will be entered into for each activity.

### **4. Terms and Conditions**

- A. The cost of Research, Training, Case Study, and Project infrastructure at SMIT should be borne by SMIT an exception software will be borne by AICL if it exceeds more than one machine and it will be borne SMIT.
- B. For continuing software training, Research, Training, Case studies, and projects for SMIT students, the financial arrangements will be made on mutually-agreed terms & Fees structures will be varied according to the courses and the fee amount will be applicable for the minimum 50 number of students If the students count below 50no's fee's structure will be varied according to the T & C and the 50%of the project, the amount must be handed over while starting the project.
- C. After the successful training, the assessment will be conducted by AICL and certification will be provided by AICL, either institute shall terminate this CONTRACT 90 days prior to the Notice by the other Institute.

### **5. Confidentially**

- A. AICL and the SMIT agree to hold in confidence all information/data designated by the institute as being confidential which is abended from either the institute or created during the performance of the CONTRACT and will not disclose the same to any third party without the written consent of the other institutes.
- B. The above confidential clause under this CONTRACT excludes the information/ data possessed by either. Institute before entering this CONTRACT or independently developed and/or information already available through the public domain.

**6. Duration of Contract**

Unless extended by mutual written consent of the institutes, this CONTRACT shall expires THREE years after the effective date specified in the opening paragraph. However, on review, CONTRACT shall be extended for another TWO years by mutual consent.

**7. Coordinators**

Both Institutes will designate persons who will have the responsibility of coordinating and implementing this agreement.

**8. Intellectual Property Rights**

The intellectual Property rights (IP) that arise because of joint Research and collaborative activity under the agreement will be worked out on a case-to-case basis and will be consistent with officially laid down the IP policies of the two Institutes.

**9. Signed in Duplicate**

This MoU is executed in duplicate with each copy being an official version and having equal legal validity. By signing below, the institutes, acting by their duly authorized officers, have caused this MoU to be executed, effective as of the day and year above mentioned.
