THIS MEMORANDUM sets out the principles of association and roles expected from both parties as follows.

1. The company/ firm shall be responsible for upkeep of the space allotted to them and also for the working condition of the equipment's allotted to them, except normal wear and tear.
2. The equipment's allotted to the company/ firm shall be used only for activities of the company/ firm. Space shall not be sublet to any other individual/ operations.

- a) Exchange of personnel through deputation as per the rules of the respective institute, for limited periods as mutually agreed upon;
- b) Organization of joint conferences and seminars;
- c) Practical training of SRI MUTHUKUMARAN INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY students at SUN SOFTWARE SOLUTIONS;
- d) Joint guidance of student projects/thesis and other areas of national interest at SMIT by SUN SOFTWARE SOLUTIONS on mutually agreeable terms.
- e) SUN SOFTWARE SOLUTIONS would accommodate B.Tech. students who have completed the 6 semesters of their programme in such a number that SUN SOFTWARE SOLUTIONS deems convenient to it for the purpose of imparting industrial training.
- f) SUN SOFTWARE SOLUTIONS may depute its personnel as visiting faculty at SMIT to teach any of the regular Course or specialized topics. Such Courses maybe run at any mutually convenient premises.

To involve students to contribute to the current open-source technologies and get them equipped to the recent trends so that they become employable in many companies.

- A) SUN SOFTWARE SOLUTIONS may seek assistance/guidance of SMIT faculty member/s in product/process modification, modernization, trouble shooting, etc.
- B) Would allow the industrial visits of students for half/full day to provide them with an

D) SUN SOFTWARE SOLUTIONS may avail library, Internet, computational facilities at SMIT.

E) The students will carry out part of their project at SMIT and SUN SOFTWARE SOLUTIONS depending on the nature of the work as per rules of the respective institute depending on facilities and requirements.

To enhance the student's capacity in industrial training, practical training, research, skill development leads to secure placements, leadership, promote entrepreneurship project work, internship. To facilitate learning and sharing best practices from industry to develop students' community

3. The Company/ firm shall ensure that their activities do not disrupt any of the activities of the Departments in the Campus. They shall also abide by the general rules and guidelines of conduct of the campus, in so far as it is applicable to them.
4. Any dispute arising out of the MoU shall be attempted to be settled by mutual discussions between the advisory board and the representatives of the company/ firm, before recourse to legal action.
5. Any interaction between **Sri Muthukumaran Institute of Technology** and the company which involves IPR shall be based on a written agreement
6. The undersigned have read and agreed to all the terms above.

#### EFFECTIVE DATE AND DURATION OF MOU

- a) This MOU shall be effective from the date of its approval by competent authorities at both ends.
- b) The duration of the MOU shall be for a period of 5 years w.e.f date of signing.
- c) During its tenancy, the MOU may be extended or terminated by a prior notice of not less than six months by either party. However, termination of the MOU will not in any manner affect the interests of the students/faculty/scientists who have been admitted to pursue a programme under the MOU.
- d) Any clause or article of the MOU may be modified or amended by mutual agreement of Sri Muthukumaran Institute of Technology and SUN SOFTWARE SOLUTIONS.

### RESOLUTION OF DISPUTES

- a) This agreement shall take effect and be construed in accordance with the Laws of India and be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts at Hyderabad.
- b) The dispute or difference whatsoever arises between PARTIES in relation to or in connection with this AGREEMENT both the parties shall first try to resolve the dispute/difference amicably between themselves, failing which the matter shall be referred to and settled through arbitration. The arbitration proceedings shall be held in accordance with the provision of Indian Arbitration and Reconciliation ACT, 1996. The venue of arbitration shall be New Delhi and Language of arbitration shall be English.
